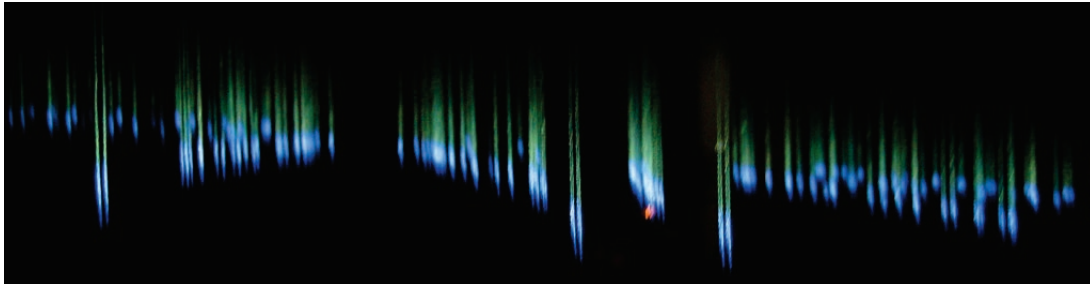

A new collaboration by Christopher Baker + R. Justin Stewart



Quincy Street Project Space is dedicated to experimental work from local, national, and international contemporary emerging artists. With a general focus on media art, the *Duets* series explores the conversation between two unique artists and their work in 730 square feet of warehouse space.

We are honored to present a collaboration by new media artist Christopher Baker and installation-based sculptor R. Justin Stewart. While working in different media, they share a central concern with networks, systems, and situations. Both currently live and work in Minneapolis.

In this installation, miles of thin blue string divide the space, silently running together and apart in a complex series of meetings, crossings and clusters. Periodically, fragmented bands of light slice through the darkness and traverse the tense material network. Each luminescent excursion reveals new pathways and suggests alternate abstract mappings. With every unique tracer, unexplored locales of density and rest are momentarily illuminated and then hidden within the otherwise invisible web.

This is the first multi-media collaboration between Christopher Baker and R. Justin Stewart.
